- Logan & CREW have their Bible Study every Wednesday as well from 6pm–8pm.

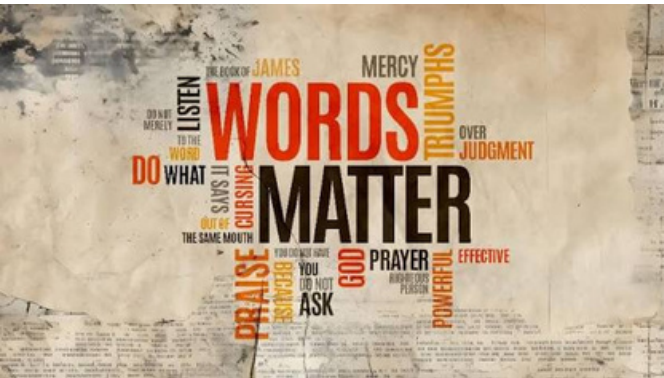
