

## **DEVOTION:**

Thanksgiving is more than a holiday—it's a posture of the heart. Psalm 107 reminds us that gratitude begins with recognizing who God is: good and full of enduring love.

Often, our thankfulness can depend on circumstances. When life feels abundant, gratitude flows easily. But Scripture calls us to something deeper—a gratitude anchored in God's unchanging character, not in our ever-changing situations.
