



A Heart Restored —

— Psalm 51:10

DEVOTION:

Psalm 51 is David's raw prayer of repentance after recognizing his sin. It's a reminder that no one is beyond God's mercy. David doesn't try to hide his guilt; instead, he brings it honestly before God, asking for cleansing, renewal, and restoration.

This psalm teaches us that:

1. **God values a contrite heart.** True repentance is more than remorse—it's turning toward God with sincerity.
2. **Forgiveness brings transformation.** When we confess, God doesn't just forgive; He reshapes our hearts and restores our spirit.
3. **God desires our whole life.** David asks for a clean heart and a right spirit—not just the surface, but the innermost being. God seeks to transform us from the inside out.

Application:

Take a moment to reflect on areas of your life where you need God's cleansing. Confess openly, not in shame, but in faith that He restores.

Pray: "Lord, I acknowledge my sin. Create in me a clean heart, renew my spirit, and guide me in your ways. Help me walk in your mercy today and always."
