



So if I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have set you an example, that you also should do as I have done to you.

—John 13:14-15

DEVOTION:

Maundy Thursday remembers the night Jesus shared His last meal with His disciples and gave a “new commandment” (from *mandatum*, meaning command):

“Love one another: just as I have loved you.”

In **John 13**, Jesus does something shocking—He washes His disciples' feet. The One they called Lord takes the role of a servant.

This shows us three powerful truths:

- **Love is humble** – real love stoops low
- **Love is active** – it serves, not just feels
- **Love is sacrificial** – it gives even when it costs

Jesus knew betrayal, suffering, and the cross were hours away—and still chose to love fully.

Devotional Prayer

Lord Jesus,

On this holy night, help me remember Your love that serves and sacrifices.

Teach me to love others not just in words, but in action and humility.

Give me a heart willing to kneel, to forgive, and to give.

As You shared the bread and cup, remind me that Your love was given for me.

Let my life reflect Your command: to love as You have loved.
